

## Pearson Test of English Young Learners

These tests are designed for young learners in the early stages of English language learning.

Results are issued as PASS WITH DISTINCTION, PASS WITH MERIT, PASS or BELOW PASS. Successful candidates have met the assessment criteria set out below.

### Level 1: Firstwords

Can read the Latin alphabet and recognise key words and phrases in both written and spoken English. Can understand and talk about basic facts related to their own lives and environment.

### Level 2: Springboard

In addition to the skills required at Firstwords:

Can talk about their feelings, habits, likes and dislikes.

Can form questions to obtain this information from others. Can read and listen with an understanding of key information.

Can write a simple text about their own life to a standard that communicates meaning.

### Level 3: Quickmarch

In addition to the skills required at Firstwords and Springboard:

Can read texts with understanding, and understand the gist and key information in familiar listening contexts. Can talk about their own lives in terms of habits, likes, dislikes, future plans and past events.

Can write a simple text about their own life or a familiar environment to a standard that can readily be understood.

### Level 4: Breakthrough

In addition to the skills required at Firstwords, Springboard and Quickmarch:

Can produce short simple coherent written texts on familiar subjects for everyday purposes to a standard that communicates with ease.

An asterisk (\*) indicates that the test was conducted under special arrangements, details of which may be obtained from Pearson Language Tests.
